Booking information

We ask guests to come in as few cars as possible because of limited parking. For those arriving by train at Moreton-in-Marsh is six miles away. Taxi phone numbers: 07800 957646 and 07565 521833.

For precise location of The House of Bread, use this link w3w.co/protect.leaps.community (this link can be used with the what3words app which links to Apple or Google satnav). It is midway between the junctions to Tidmington and Burmington, west of the A3400, south of Shipston-on-Stour, just after a red triangle junction road sign.

Meeting rooms and catering

We only offer self-catering accommodation, we can recommend a caterer. The main Mill building has four floors. The first floor has a large meeting room, seating up to 50, an adjoining large lounge and a small lounge.

The ground floor has a large dining or conference room, seating up to 50, and a fully equipped self-catering kitchen; also a small lounge.

Another fully-equipped self-catering kitchen and dining room, seating up to 30, is situated on the second floor of the Mill.

Guests have use of one of the fully-equipped self-catering kitchens and dining rooms. Tea bags and coffee are provided. Milk is provided for day guests, please bring your own milk if you are residential. The House of Bread is an alcohol-free site.

Individuals will have use of lounge areas that are available during their stay. When making a group booking, please let us know the number of meeting rooms required, as some of the meeting rooms may be used by other groups on site.

Guests are very welcome to enjoy the gardens and surrounding land. There are also many local walks to be enjoyed. We appreciate it if guests can bring a change of shoes for indoor use.

We ask guests to please leave all the rooms they have used clean and tidy on departure. We ask groups to take out their rubbish to the appropriate bins.

Additional information for residents

The 19 bedrooms, mostly twin with en-suite, sleeping a maximum of 36 guests, are situated on the top two floors of the Mill. Each bedroom has tea and coffee making facilities.

Small group bookings may share bedroom accommodation, not bedrooms, with another group.

Bed linen is provided but all guests need to bring towels and toiletries. On the morning of departure we ask guests to remove the used bed linen and remake their bed with fresh bed linen; and that bedrooms are vacated by 10am, unless another time is agreed.

We ask guests to be respectful of other guests and our neighbours by being quiet between 11pm and 8am inside and outside the building.

It is very much appreciated if guests can empty their bedroom bins and if groups can vacuum the meeting rooms.

The Alpha Suite

The Alpha Suite is a separate meeting room to the main Mill building. It is on ground level, it seats up to 40 people, and has a kitchen and toilets.

Community

Every week day from 9am-9:30am the community meets together for an informal time of Bible reading, worship and prayer. You are very welcome to join us for these times.

Accessibility

Please discuss with us the needs of your group when making a booking. We only have sleeping accommodation on the second and third floor of the main Mill building. The first and second floors of the Mill can be accessed by a single seat stairlift - we do not have a lift for a wheelchair. None of our bedrooms have bathroom facilities for people with physical disabilities, but we do have wheelchair access into the toilets on the ground floor of the Mill, the Alpha Suite and the Barn.
